Decisions

The Deputies

1. authorised the Secretary General to sign, on behalf of the Council of Europe, the Agreement between the Council of Europe and Ukraine on the Establishment of the Special Tribunal for the Crime of Aggression against Ukraine with the Statute of the Special Tribunal annexed thereto, as they appear in documents CM(2025)104-final and CM(2025)103-final;
2. having regard to the provisions of Resolution Res(93)28 on partial and enlarged agreements, as well as of Resolution Res(96)36 establishing the criteria for partial and enlarged agreements of the Council of Europe, as amended by Resolution CM/Res(2010)2, and subject to the procedure outlined in paragraph 3 below, authorised the establishment of an Enlarged Partial Agreement on the Management Committee of the Special Tribunal for the Crime of Aggression against Ukraine, based on the draft Resolution as it appears in document CM(2025)105, by interested member or observer States of the Council of Europe, the European Union, and any other State that has voted in favour of the United Nations General Assembly Resolution A/RES/ES-11/6 of 23 February 2023, or any State that has participated in the Core Group for the Establishment of the Special Tribunal for the Crime of Aggression against Ukraine;
3. agreed to resume consideration of this item with a view to adopting the draft Resolution establishing the Enlarged Partial Agreement on the Management Committee once a sufficient number of States have pledged to ensure the sustainability, including in budgetary terms, of the Special Tribunal for the Crime of Aggression against Ukraine; for this purpose, they instructed the GT-TRIBUNAL to continue the examination of this item, including detailed budget proposals presented as soon as possible, and to report back; and invited those States which so wish, as well as the European Union, to notify the Secretary General in writing of their intention to join the Enlarged Partial Agreement.
