

Overview:

Pakistan is prone to a number of hazards, in particular storms and flooding that occur frequently and induce significant humanitarian impact. This Inter-Agency Monsoon Contingency Plan acknowledges the lead role of the Government in all aspects of disaster management and the role of humanitarian and development partners in supporting national emergency preparedness and response structures and capacities. It supports the Government in ensuring an effective, timely and coordinated response to mitigate the risk and reduce the impact of natural disasters on communities, through a clear response coordination mechanism and strategy, and clearly defined roles and responsibilities.

For analysis and planning purposes, this plan focuses on four different scenarios for large-scale monsoon flood disasters. For reference purposes, protocols, coordination arrangements and information sharing approaches are included.
