


## PAKISTAN **Monsoon Contigency Plan 2025**

## **Overview:**

Pakistan is prone to a number of hazards, in particular storms and flooding that occur frequently and induce significant humanitarian im This Inter-Agency Monsoon Contingency Plan acknowledges the lea role of the Government in all aspects of disaster management and the role of humanitarian and development partners in supporting national emergency preparedness and response structures and capacities. It supports the Government in ensuring an effective, timely and coordi response to mitigate the risk and reduce the impact of natural disast on communities, through a clear response coordination mechanism strategy, and clearly defined roles and responsibilities.


